
OUR VISION

The Junior League of Panama City works to identify the unmet needs in our community and develops unique programs to fulfill those needs along with the resources and trained volunteers to sustain those programs. Our organization provides Bay County with a valuable commodity – trained volunteers for community and civic leadership.

OUR COMMUNITY IMPACT

With more than 350 members, our organization implements research and development of community programs in Bay County through service projects, collaborations, education, and advocacy. Each year our members contribute more than 5,000 volunteer hours to support outreach programs and carry out our mission. Last year, hundreds of underserved children were clothed and given basic hygiene items through our Child Service Center program. Additionally, more than 100 children were taught healthy eating habits while having fun through our Kids in the Kitchen program. Through a partnership with Bay Education Foundation, JLPC helped to award \$14,500 to area teachers for innovative classroom use. These are just a few of the projects where JLPC volunteers impact our community. By supporting our mission, you are making a lasting investment for the present and future needs of Bay County.


